



Turbomachinery & Pump Symposia Advisory Committee Recruitment

The Turbomachinery & Pump Symposia (TPS) is facilitated by Turbo & Pump advisory committees made up of dedicated industry experts who volunteer their time to oversee the success of the Symposia. Advisors are respected leaders at their companies and in their fields who select the technical program for TPS each year.

Expectations vary between committees, but generally include the following:

- Support from your employer for time, travel and conference fees associated with membership
- Attend TPS (duration of 4 days)
- Participate in committee meetings in-person or via conference call (2-3 meetings annually)
- Review, monitor and select abstracts for the turbo or pump program at TPS
- Advocate on behalf TPS, encouraging program participation and attendance at the symposia within your company and network
- Act in the best interest of TPS and the Turbomachinery Laboratory by planning for the future and addressing potential concerns or challenges
