

James M. "Jim" Sorokes is an aerodynamic consultant for Fox Innovation and Technologies (FIT). He retired from Siemens-Energy (formerly Dresser-Rand) in 2021 with 45 years' experience. Jim spent most of his career in or managing the Aerodynamics Group. He became a principal engineer in 2005 and was responsible for various projects related to compressor development and testing. He was also heavily involved in mentoring and training in the field of aerodynamic design, analysis, and testing. Jim is a member of ASME and the ASME Turbomachinery Committee.
